

#### **A Word From Our Executive Director**

Dear Waste Not Supporters,

As we enter a new age of a post-lockdown world, we have seen challenges arise. Inflation. The Great Resignation. Learning the new normal. The Water Crisis. Despite all of this, Waste Not remains deeply committed to eliminating food waste and hunger here in Arizona through the values we uphold.

Before all else, we are problem-solvers. Waste Not is able to provide a unique solution to help people and the planet flourish. One, we protect the planet by diverting food away from landfills which minimizes the loss of water, energy, and money, along with the reduction of methane. Two, we use that food that would have gone to waste to help feed the nearly one million Arizonans struggling with food insecurity.

We do this through our innovative approach to food waste. Waste Not picks up food from generous donors of restaurants, hotels, grocery stores, and catering companies, and then delivers that food on the SAME day to over 85 agencies helping those who need it the most here in Arizona. The food Waste Not picks up is perishable, meaning it is usually fresh produce or ready-to-eat meals that are soon to expire. Food is looked over to determine whether or not it is safe for human consumption. If it is not, but it is still safe for animal consumption, we re-direct the food to our Farm Feed program.

At the heart of everything we do, Waste Not strives to uphold the value of compassion for the community we serve. Through the years, our mantra has become to leave things better than we found them. To take care of our environment and the people in it. We are grateful to our loyal volunteers and donors who help make what we do possible. Equally, we are honored to support the more than 85 agencies who help some of the most vulnerable in the valley through our sustainable food system.

As we look to 2023, we have never seen the demand for our services so high. We are ready to say "challenge accepted" as we head into a new year with new possibilities and new ventures.


