A WORD FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear Waste Not Supporter,

This year has been one of seizing opportunities - one food rescue at a time.

With inflation worse than ever, we've seen a tremendous uptick of need for our services. More people are out of jobs, and even those that have one are struggling to provide for themselves and their family. In fact, 68% of the nonprofit agencies we deliver food to are anticipating needing MORE in the coming year.

But that's why we're here.

Waste Not is dedicated to creating sustainable food systems that eliminate food waste and hunger through innovative partnerships. Partnerships like NFL Green and M Culinary Concepts.

In February 2023, we partnered with NFL Green for the third time to pick up excess food from Super Bowl LVII. And, for the seventh year in a row, we also picked up excess food from the WM Phoenix Open alongside our partner M Culinary Concepts. Between these two big events, we rescued 123 THOUSAND meals and redistributed them into the community.

We also continued partnering with On the Road Meals – a nutritious meal prep business that helped us provide 350 Thanksgiving meals in 2022, and our relationships with QuikTrip and Salad & Go have flourished. We rescued more than 350,000 meals worth of food from these generous partners.

Without community partners like these, millions of pounds of GOOD food would end up in the landfills instead of on the plates of the nearly one million Arizonans struggling to find their next meal.

As we step into the next year, we are encouraged by the partners we have and the new ones we are gaining. We are ready to continue helping people and the planet flourish.

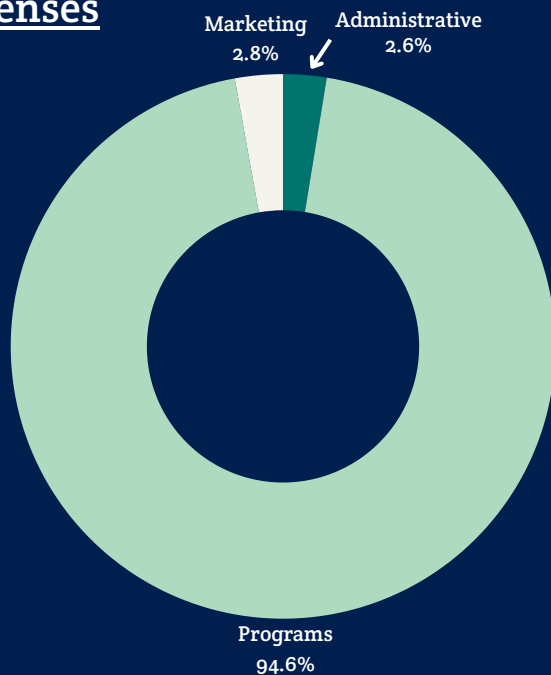

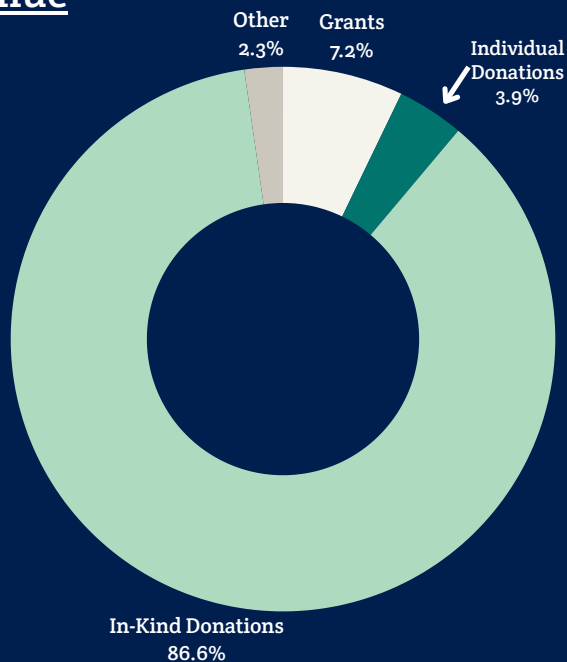

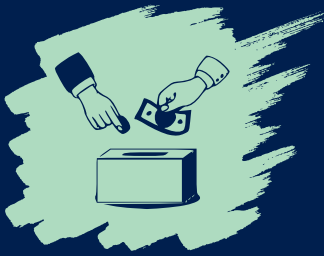
